Dear Parent/Carer

At Granville Sports College we are continually striving to provide the best possible education for your youngster, leading to our best ever exam results with last year's Year 11. Last year we had a "Prom Contract" for all Year 11 pupils to help improve educational outcomes – which certainly had an impact on their exam results.

This year we are going to implement a similar "Prom Contract" for the current Year 10 pupils so that they will have the best possible chance of succeeding in all controlled coursework and future examinations.

In order for a pupil to attend the Year 11 Prom on Friday 7th July 2017 they will need to meet the following standards throughout the year from 6th June 2016 to 26th May 2017:-

- ▶ Net conduct points must be greater than 25
- ▶ No internal or external exclusions in time period
- ▶ No more than one incident of Seclusion
- ▶ Attendance must be 96% and above
- ▶ Punctuality must be above 98% (no more than 6 times late - am and pm)
- ▶ No more than two On Calls during the time period
- ▶ Dress Code expectations must be followed all year
- ▶ Pupils should be on target grade in all subjects at tracking points and, where this is not the case, the pupil is taking positive action, as requested by the teacher, to address this
- ▶ Average Attitude to Learning Level from across the time period must be 2.5 or lower
- ▶ Pupils with 100% attendance will receive a free Prom ticket

The Senior Leadership Team reserve the right to consider any appeals against exclusion from the Prom which should be submitted in writing by 12 noon on 12th June 2016. No late appeals will be accepted. The appeals will be discussed at the Senior Leadership Team meeting on Tuesday 13th June. Letters will be sent explaining the decision on Thursday 15th June.

Year 11 will officially leave Granville Sports College on Friday 30th June 2017. Please do not book any holidays etc before this date as they will be required in school.

Please can you sign and return the reply slip to this letter (overleaf) to Mrs Sigston by Friday 17th June to acknowledge that you have read and understand the terms of this contract.
