Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

On Wednesday 18th July, we are holding our annual Charity Day, which this year will raise funds for The British Liver Trust, our school charity for the year, and for purchasing resources for our LGBTQ+ support group here in the academy.

It will be a non-uniform day and we are asking for a minimum £1 donation to be given for all students in non-uniform. We would like you to be mindful of appropriate dress code and health and safety restrictions. The following will not be permitted: crop tops (midriff must not be shown), hot pants or similar, ripped jeans (must be appropriate) clothing that it is too revealing, inappropriate slogans and unsafe footwear such as flip flops.
